29% were classed as non-verbal. 16% talk in sentences.

The rest use various methods of communication, such as sign language, to be understood.

They can understand more than they can express.

40% are diagnosed with an autism spectrum condition.





42% wake frequently during the night.

43% need additional equipment to help them get around.
And of those that can walk,
45% learnt to walk after the age of two.



57% are not toilet trained.

60% have constipation.

The following symptoms were experienced by at least 25% of people with Kleefstra syndrome:

- aspiration reflux
- hypermobility
- strabismus or unusual eye features
- heart condition
- microcephaly
- hearing impairment
- regression
- brain structure abnormalities



Children with Kleefstra syndrome are described as affectionate and they laugh a lot.
